

Getting Started:

1. Go to www.firstpick.co.nz



- 2. Enter some basic information including your T&G customer number and a contact name.
- 3. You will then receive a verification email to confirm your email address.
- 4. Once confirmed you will then have access to FirstPick straight away and can start placing your next order. If the email provided does not match what we have in our records, our customer service team will need to confirm the setup of your FirstPick account.

Frequently Asked Questions:

Who can use FirstPick?

Any customer with an active T&G NZ Markets account will be able to place orders through FirstPick. It is a **free service** offered by T&G to help make ordering easier and quicker for our customers. T&G always welcomes new customers as well – sign up online and we'll get you set up.

Where does my order go, and how do I know it will reach the right people?

Your order will be sent immediately to your local market, and distributed out to the right sales specialist for the right products. We even have you covered when one of our staff are on leave, your order will be automatically picked up by someone else on the team.

How can I make sure you'll give me the product I want?

If you have specific requirements (like a preferred grower or product size) you can include them in the **comments** box. We also have messaging where you can communicate directly with the sales specialists.

What if you haven't got the product I want quoted?

We want to help find you the products you want, so we have developed a "Request Stock" button where you can ask for anything you can't see quoted. We will then do our best to track it down for you.

Can I track progress of my order?

Yes, that is one of the big advantages of FirstPick. You will get instant feedback when each line is allocated in our system, and you will get a text or email notifications once all lines in your order have been filled.

What if I want to change or cancel my order?

You can change or cancel your order up until the time that it has been picked for you.

How often do you update the prices?

Pricing is indicative market pricing, updated as market conditions change so you'll always have the latest information at your fingertips.

Can I see my actual invoices though?

Yes, once picked, you can view and download your final invoices for the day and week straight from our system.

What about delivery?

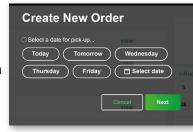
Deliveries or pickups are the same arrangement as you have now, and we aim to eventually integrate that into FirstPick.

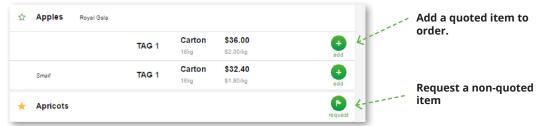
EASY ORDERING - Anywhere, Anytime!

CREATE AN ORDER

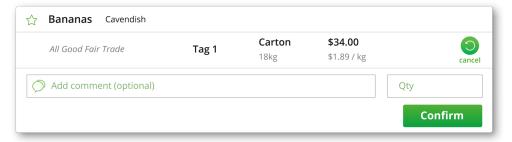
- 1. Go to 'My Orders' on the menu bar
- 2. Select 'Create New Order' and choose when you want to pick-up your order.
- 3. You will be taken to the '**Shop**' page where you can add items from the quote sheet as well as request items that have not been quoted.

(requested items may take us a little longer to source for you, but we will try our best!)

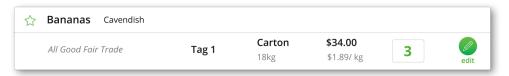




4. Click 'Add' to add the desired item to your order



- 5. Specify the quantity you would like to order and add comments if you have any specific requests (e.g. grower).
- 6. Click 'Confirm'



- 7. To modify an existing item, click 'Edit'.
- 8. When your order is complete, click '**Submit Order**' (You'll be able to edit it after submitting)

2. Click 'View' on the order you want to review

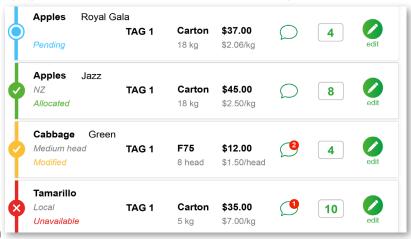
REVIEW PROGRESS OF YOUR ORDER

3. The order will be displayed with each line item and their status updates.

Pending: The item has not yet been processed by a sales specialist.

Allocated: The sales specialist has allocated the item, and the quantity as you requested.

Modified: The sales specialist has made a minor modification



to you order (e.g. quantity, size etc.) but has still allocated stock.

Unavailable: The sales specialist has not been able to allocate any stock this time.

Unsubmitted:

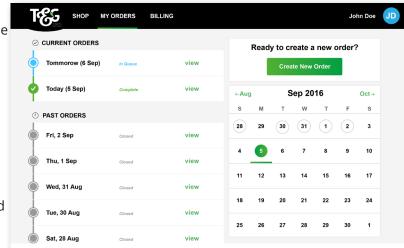
You have created the order but have not yet sent it to us.
